Letter of Request

A letter to request the Sacrament of Confirmation is to be written to our Bishop William Mc Grattan

This letter should be typed and should contain reasons as to why Father Marius should recommend that you receive Confirmation. Some suggestions for content include: why you decided to complete your initiation into the Church at this time; various projects you have undertaken as a sign of your service to the community; why you value being a Catholic and how your faith has helped you to be a good person. You might also mention your hopes and dreams as a young Catholic trying to follow the model of Jesus Christ. There are many possible things you can include in your letter. Only you can decide what is best for you and what will best present your case.

The letter should be written to Bishop Frederick Henry, enclosed in an envelope with his name on it, and returned to the Parish Office who will pass it on to Bishop William Mc Grattan. It should arrive by February 23, 2017.
