

PARISH RENEWAL

Last October on the Memorial of St. Francis of Assisi, coinciding with the Synodal Assembly in Rome, Bishop McGrattan issued a diocesan letter announcing the launch of a pathway of pastoral renewal in the Diocese of Calgary. In the letter Bishop McGrattan outlined the three areas of pastoral priority that were discerned from the diocesan synod.

As part of the Diocesan Pastoral Renewal Process, with the guidance and inspiration of our pastor, Father James, a group of parishioners were called to be part of the Renewal Process for St. Gabriel Parish. We answered the call and have formed the initial Parish Renewal Team.

As a parish renewal team, we have begun our own formation on the diocesan renewal process. Over the next months and years, we will be developing and revising, with your help, a parish pastoral renewal plan with actions on how we as a parish can be constantly renewing our selves and adapting to continue to be the living Church for our faith community.

In June of this year the diocese will be providing a parish member survey; watch for more details at a later date. Following the survey and through the fall of 2024, the parish renewal team will begin the work to develop a parish renewal plan. Implementation is planned to take place over the following 3 years.

For anyone interested in learning more about the renewal process, a **Parish Gathering** will be held on: **Wednesday, June 5th at St. Gabriel School.**
